M-Flow uses the technologically advanced VIDR-1000→ Telematic hub delivering lowest cost routing of data direct to its users from the AES emergency services fleet back office system. Key features include: alerts and bulk data over integral GPRS modem and on platform integrated TETRA applications; and free at point of use integral wireless modem transmitting efficiently bulk journey, accident data and driver performance elements of the system.

The rollout of WiFi sites throughout several key police customers and the long term trial and evalua-

tion of the system with other significant UK police and fire and rescue service fleets demonstrates that an integrated communication system approach is the right one, says AES. The M-Flow system ([www.mflow.co.uk](http://www.mflow.co.uk)) works with whole organisation project teams driving fleet costs down, meeting duty of care legislation, hitting environmental and utilisation targets and providing dynamic driver training.
